

PRIVACY NOTICE ON COOKIES

As **TAV Airports Holding Joint Stock Company** (“**TAV Airports**” or the “**Company**”), we use certain technologies such as cookies, pixels, and GIFs (“**Cookies**”) to enhance your experience during your visits to our online platforms. The use of these technologies is carried out in compliance with the applicable legislation, primarily the **Law No. 6698 on the Protection of Personal Data** (“**PDP Law**”).

The purpose of this Cookie Notice is to inform you about the processing of personal data obtained during the use of Cookies by users/members/visitors (“**Data Subjects**”) of the website operated by us (the “**Website**”). Through this Cookie Notice, we aim to explain which types of Cookies we use on our Website, for what purposes, and how you can control these Cookies.

As TAV Airports, we may discontinue the use of Cookies on our Website, change their types or functions, or add new Cookies. Therefore, we reserve the right to amend the provisions of this Cookie Notice at any time. Any changes made to the current Cookie Notice shall become effective upon publication on the Website or any publicly accessible platform. You may find the latest update date at the beginning of this Cookie Notice.

Which Cookies Are Used for Which Purposes?

General

As TAV Airports, we use Cookies on our Website for various purposes and process your personal data through these Cookies. These purposes mainly include:

- To perform the basic functions necessary for the operation of the Website. For example, ensuring that logged-in users do not need to re-enter their passwords when navigating between different pages on the Website.
- To analyze the Website and improve its performance. For example, integrating different servers on which the Website operates, determining the number of visitors, and making performance adjustments accordingly or facilitating visitors in finding what they are looking for.

Pursuant to Article 5 of the Law on the Protection of Personal Data, your personal data is processed by automated means for the purposes stated above, based on the following legal grounds: (i) it is necessary for the data controller to fulfill its legal obligations, (ii) it is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests of the data controller, provided that it does not harm the fundamental rights and freedoms of the data subject, and (iii) your explicit consent.

As TAV Airports, we may share your personal data within the scope of this Cookie Notice, limited to the realization of the purposes stated above and in compliance with the applicable legislation, with our service providers and our group companies.

Cookies Used on Our Website

Below you can find different types of Cookies used on our Website. Both first-party Cookies (placed by the Website you visit) and third-party Cookies (placed by servers other than the Website you visit) are used.

Strictly Necessary Cookies

The use of certain Cookies is essential for the proper functioning of our Website. For example, authentication Cookies activated when you log in ensure that your session continues as you navigate between pages.

Cookie	Description
BIGipServer*	Maintains session persistence by ensuring that the client reconnects to the same pool member initially connected to.
TS01*	Ensures that your web requests are consistently processed by the same server throughout your session.
.AspNetCore.Culture	Stores your language/culture preferences.
.AspNetCore.Antiforgery.*	Provides security against cross-site request forgery (CSRF).
cc_cookie_demo2	Stores your cookie consent preferences.

Performance and Analytics Cookies

These Cookies allow us to analyze your use of our Website and improve its performance. For example, they help us identify which pages are most frequently visited, whether the Website functions properly, and detect potential issues.

Cookies	Description
_ga	Set by Google Analytics to calculate visitor, session, and campaign data.
ga*	Used by Google Analytics to store and count page views.
_gid	Set by Google Analytics to distinguish users (24-hour duration).
_gat / gat*	Used by Google Analytics to throttle request rate.
__utma	Legacy Google Analytics cookie; distinguishes users and sessions.
__utmb	Legacy Google Analytics cookie; determines new sessions/visits.
__utmc	Legacy Google Analytics cookie; used for session identification.
__utmz	Legacy Google Analytics cookie; stores traffic source or campaign.
__utmt	Legacy Google Analytics cookie; limits request rate.
