


Kazakhstan is the largest landlocked country in the world

Kazakhstan ranks 25th among 190 countries in the World Bank Doing Business Index.




Kazakhstan is projected to lead Central Asia in economic growth, with its GDP expected to rise by 5.5% in 2025, an increase of 1.5 percentage points from the previous year.

Almaty airport (ALA) catchment area covers:

- A 1M population within 30 minutes driving distance
- A 2M population within 60 minutes driving distance
- A 3.5M population within 120 minutes driving distance

Conveniently located within a reach from the main touristic attractions:

- City center of Almaty within 45 minutes driving distance.
- Chimbulak Ski Station within 1 hour driving distance.
- **Charyn Canyon** within 2h45 driving distance.






