



Located on the Gulf of Hammamet in Northern Tunisia, the city offers various activities, from seaside tourism to cultural visits.

In the South, the **Yasmine Hammamet is the main touristic resort,** developed during the 90's to bring quality infrastructures and touristic attractions.



Hammamet is known for being an **eclectic tourism destination**, with a traditional city center, beautiful beaches and a dynamic night life.

Hammamet Airport (NBE) catchment area covers:

- The city of Sousse within 45 minutes driving distance (45 km), counting 222K inhabitants.
- The city of Tunis, within 1h15 driving distance (108 km), counting 610K inhabitants.

Conveniently located within a reach of the main touristic attractions:

- Hammamet City Center, within 40 minutes driving distance.
- Carthage within 1h30 driving distance.

Hammamet is one of the main seaside destination of Tunisia, offering long sand beaches and a dynamic city.



Palaces, holiday clubs or traditional hotels, all sorts can be found in Hammamet. Around the city, numerous seaside hotels with a typically Tunisian charm fringe the beaches.



Catamaran sailing and scuba diving, plus as well as water-skiing, jet skiing, canoeing and paddle boarding.



Enjoy Hammamet's 2 golf courses: the-Citrus Golf Course, with 45 holes surrounded by olive groves, steep forest hills, and lakes, and the Yasmine Golf Course, with 18 holes in large greens and creative water obstacles.



The mansion, Dar Sebastian, is open to visitors and surrounded by a luxurious botanical garden; today it is the International Cultural Centre of Hammamet.



Known as Thalassotherapy and first appreciated by the ancient Romans, the technique of using seawater for its therapeutic benefits has been refined at over 60 luxury spas dedicated to your wellbeing.



Hammamet is an ideal destination for MICE tourism. The Medina Convention & Expo Centre has facilities up to 2,500 delegates and meeting rooms. The Hammamet Congress Palace offers a 700-seats conference room and meeting & exhibition areas.


