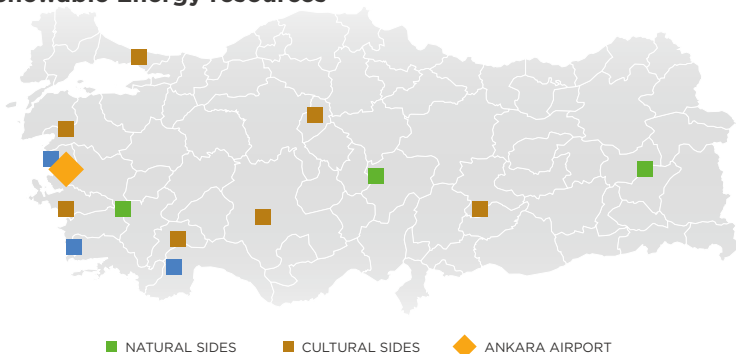
Renewable Energy resources

Izmir Airport (ADB) catchment area covers:

- A 2M population within 30 minutes driving distance
- A 4M population within 60 minutes driving distance
- A 6M population within 120 minutes driving distance

- **Çeşme** within 1 hour driving distance.
- **Kuşadası** within 70 minutes driving distance.

Medical Tourism

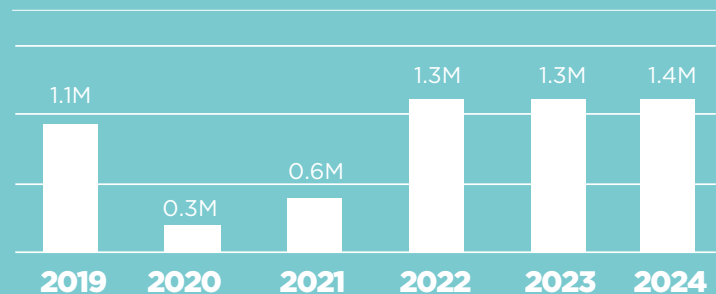
With 48 hospitals and a 12K bed capacity, Izmir attracted more than 60K foreign patients in 2023.



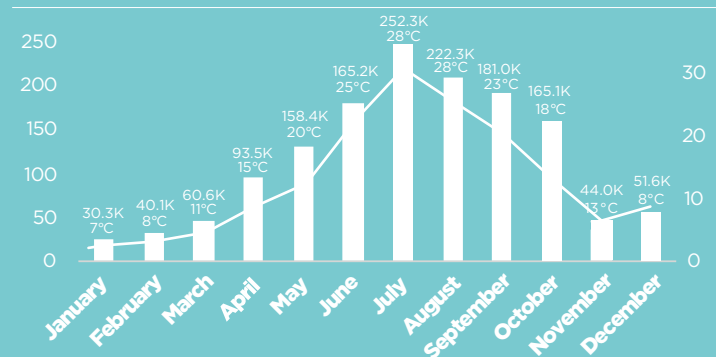
Business Events

Marketing support and incentive schemes tailored on airlines' development projects.



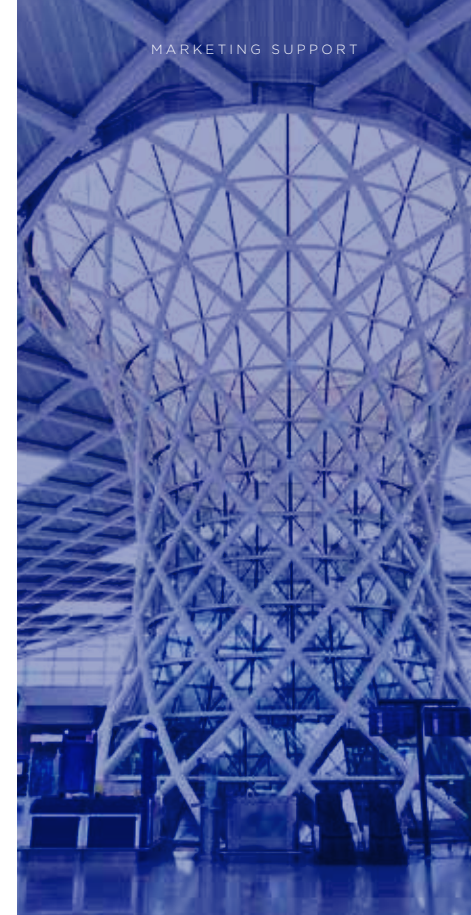
