Ajara's economy is also based on growing tobacco, tea and citrus fruits.


Batumi Airport (BUS) is conveniently located within a reach from the main touristic attractions:

- The **city center of Batumi** within 15 minutes driving distance (6 km).
- The **Mtirala National Park** within 1 hour driving distance).
- The Machakhela National Park within 50 minutes driving distance.
- The **Gonio Fortress** within 10 minutes driving distance.









## ■ BATUMI, Getaway to Adjara

Even in the coldest months, the temperature doesn't go lower than +7-10 degrees which is why you may visit Batumi at any time of the year.



Adjara seaside is with the subtropical climate, 21-kilometer long coastline, the warm sea of 21-29 Celsius on average, comfortable atmosphere and distinctive nature. Besides leisure, Batumi resort has solar therapy and sea-salt baths to offer



Batumi Boulevard is the main and most visited sightseeing of the city. The recreation zone, which at the same time is a cultural heritage monument, for centuries, has unites the city's guests or native inhabitants.



Gambling is popular in Batumi, with many casinos located in upscale hotels, attracting both locals and tourists. Recent hotel constructions suggest further growth in the city's casino industry.




Batumi Botanical Garden located at the distance of 9 km from the center of Batumi, occupies the area of 108.7 hectare
