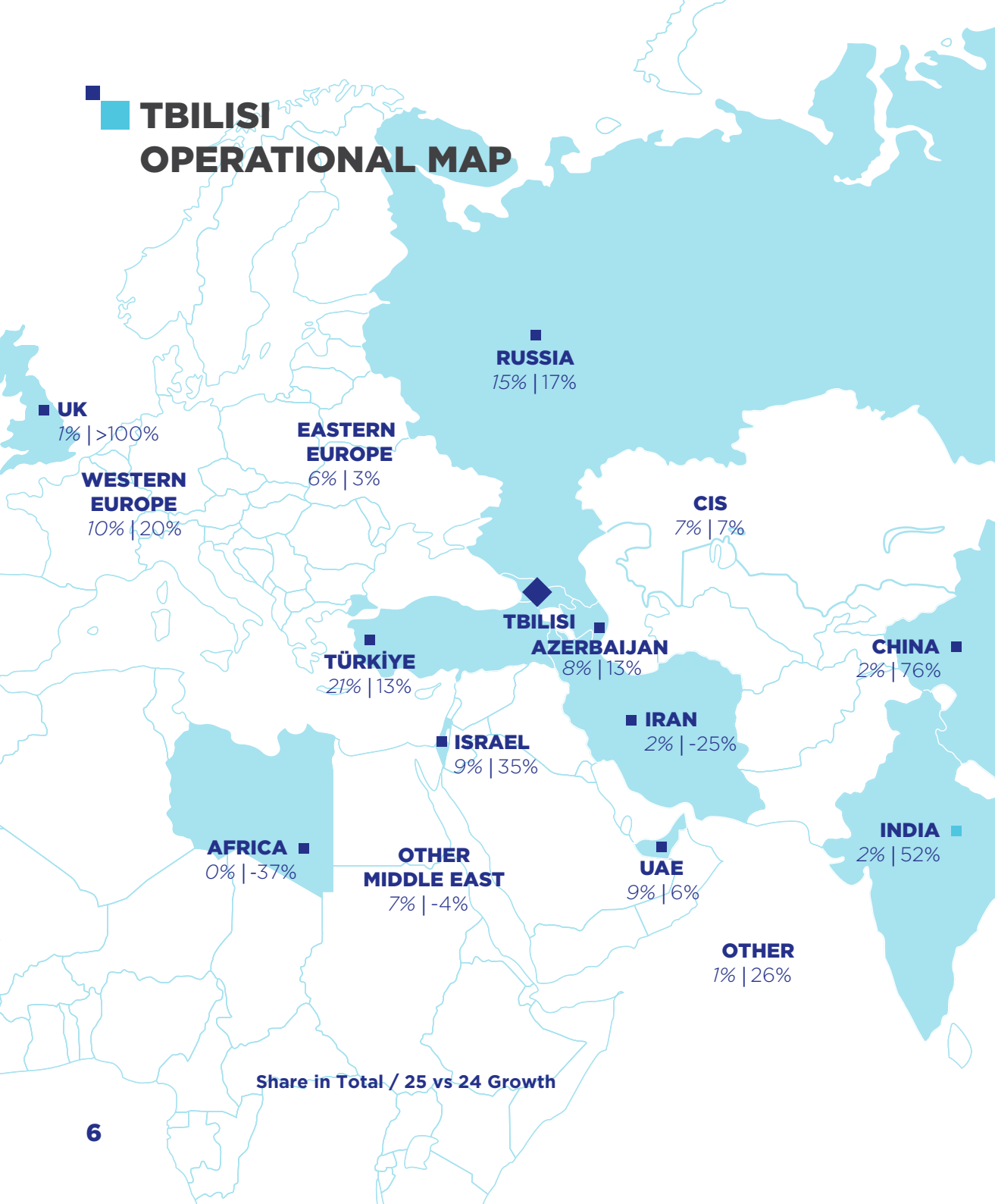

European Parliament has adopted the visa liberalization for Georgia. Georgian nationals are able to travel visa-free within the Schengen area.

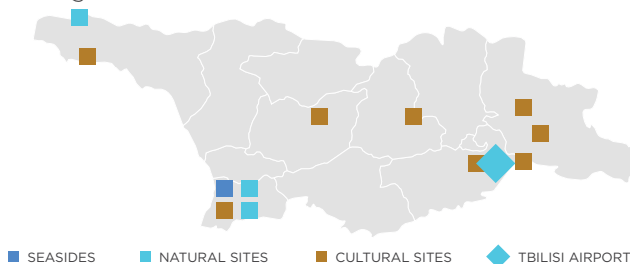

Tbilisi Airport (TBS) catchment area covers:

- A **1.5M population** within 30 minutes driving distance
- A **3M population** within 60 minutes driving distance
- A **5M population** within 120 minutes driving distance

Conveniently located within a reach of the main touristic attractions:

- The **city center of Tbilisi** within 30 minutes driving distance (20 km).
- **Kakheti's wineries** within 1 hour driving distance.
- **Gareji Caves** within 90 minutes driving distance.

Caucasian mountains offer breathtaking sceneries for hiking. Kazbegi is one of the most stunning mountain regions in Georgia.

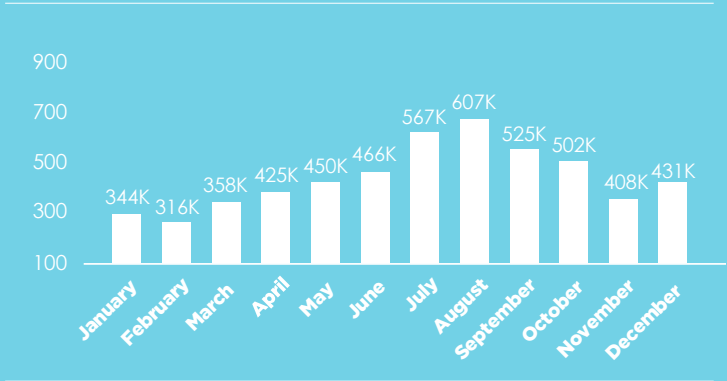


Monasteries

SEASONALITY (2025)

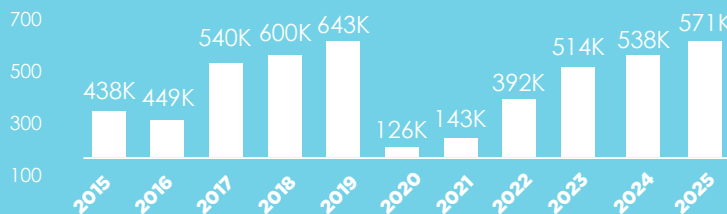

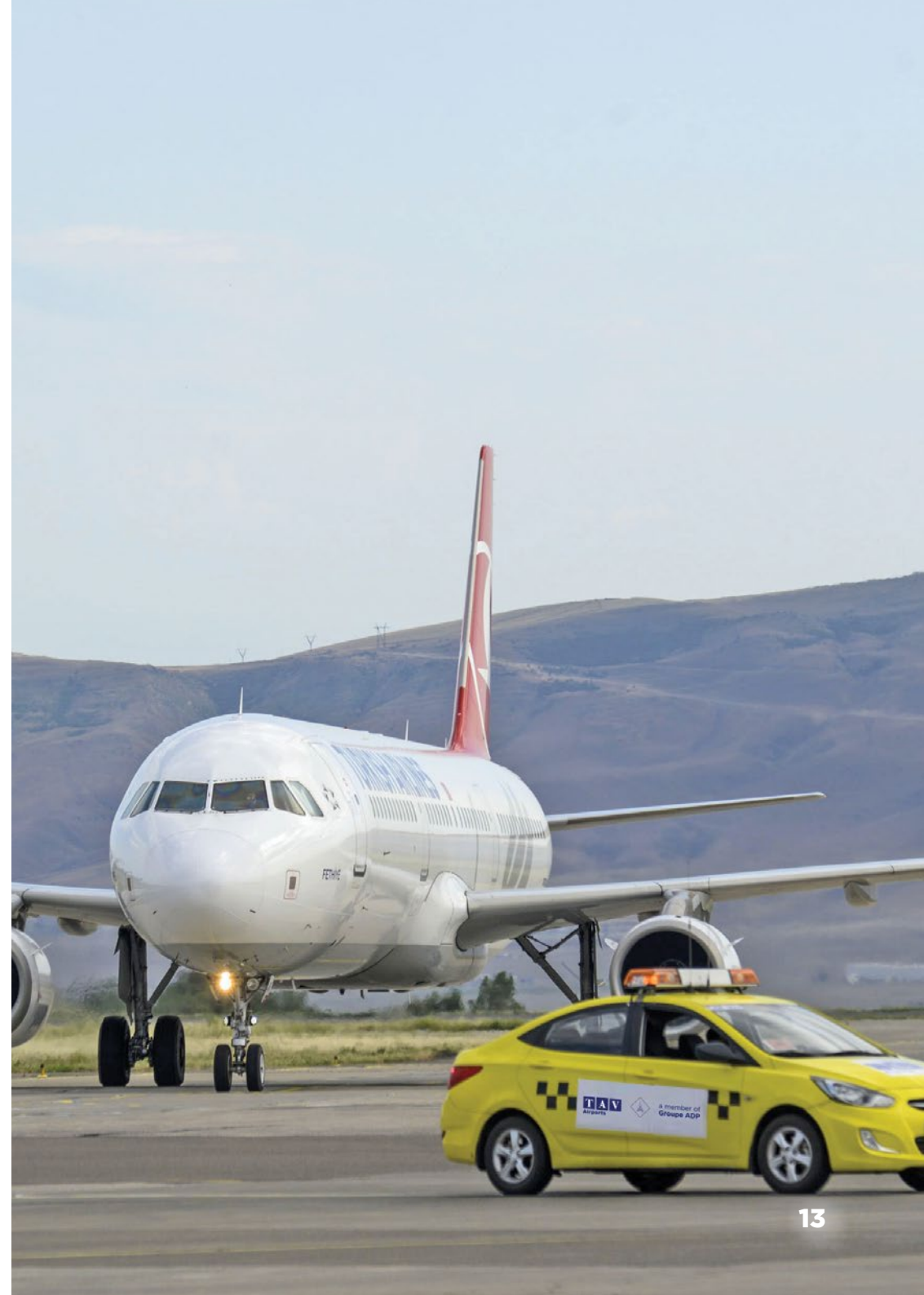

Tbilisi International Airport

The main international airport in Georgia, located 17 km southeast of the capital Tbilisi.

The construction of Tbilisi International Airport was completed in February 2007, the project included construction of a new international terminal, car park, improvements to the apron, taxiway and runway and acquisition of ground handling equipment. In 2016-17 TAV Georgia implemented a Runway and Taxiways rehabilitation project, New aircraft parking positions and construction of a New Arrival Terminal at Tbilisi International Airport. According to the statistical reports of 2025 Tbilisi International Airport provided services to 5,396,609 million passengers during the year.

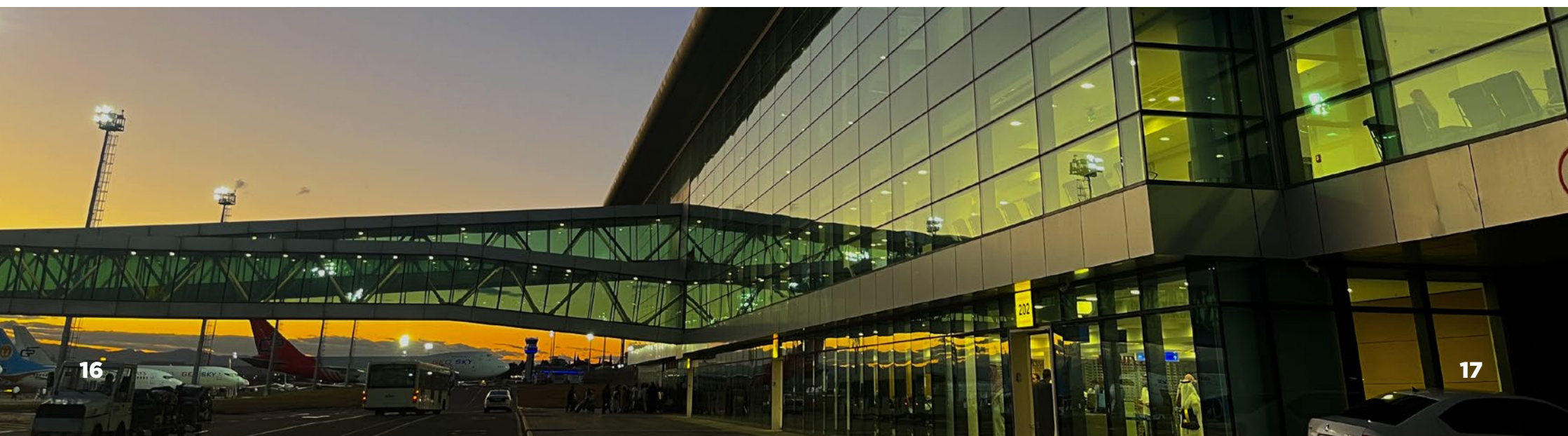

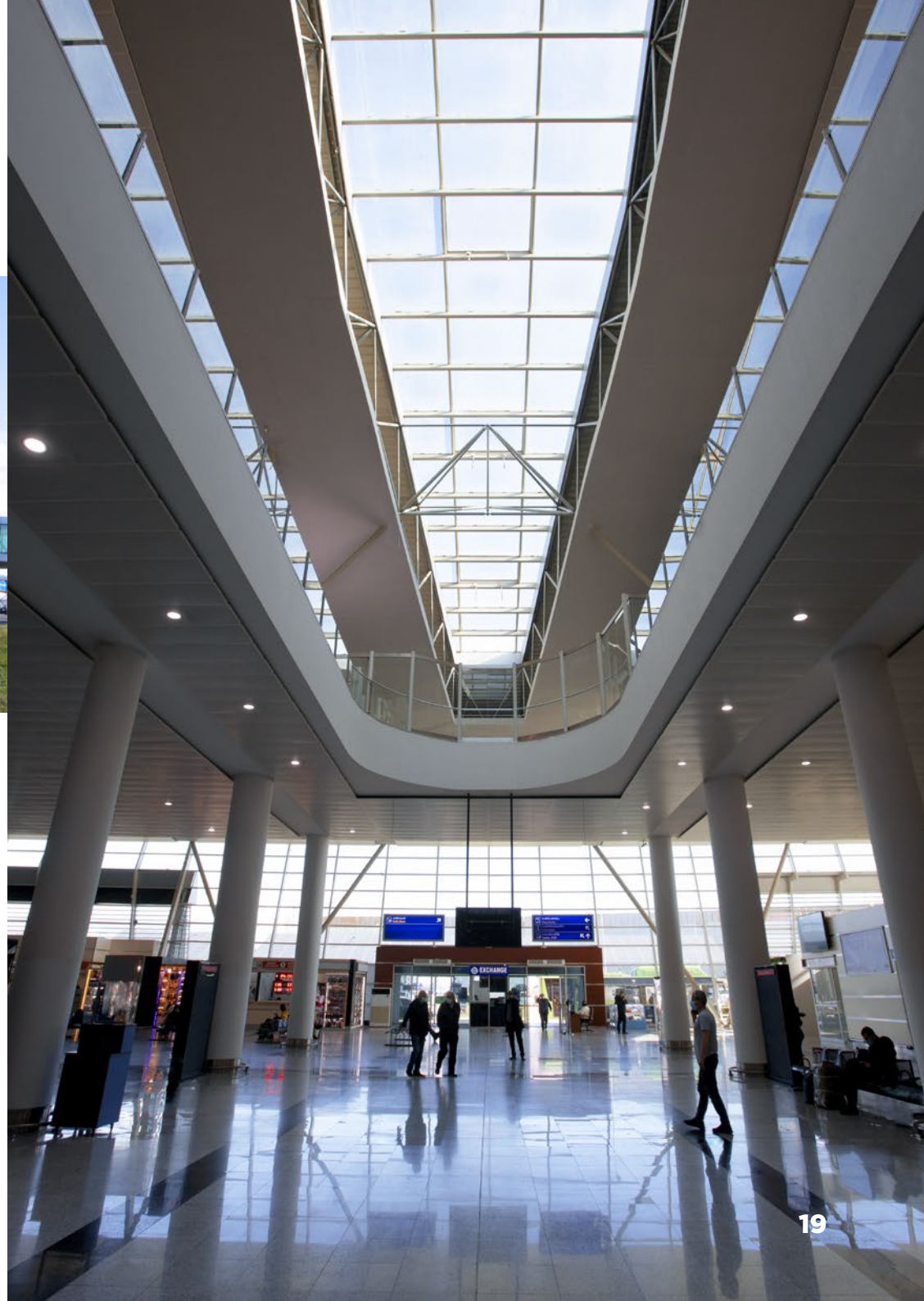

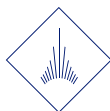
